Northwood Zoo Tour

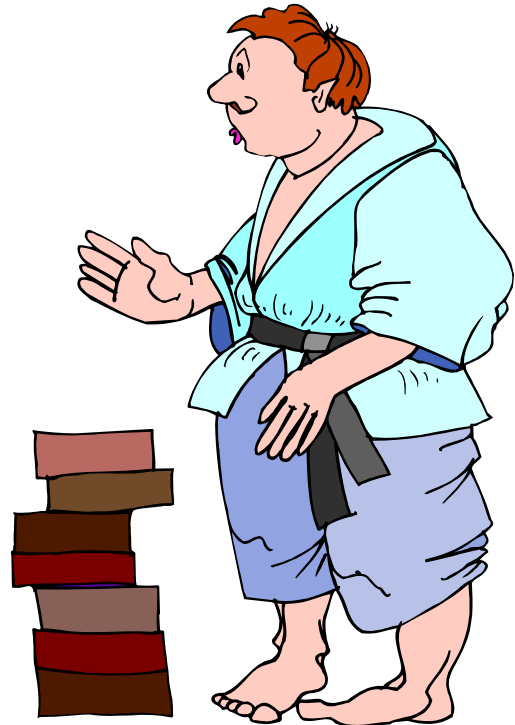
Thursday July 17
